BOOK REVIEW

POYLN: JEWISH LIFE IN THE OLD COUNTRY By Alter Kacyzne

Poyln is a pictorial view of Poland in the 1920s. Pictures of the market place, work, home and synagogues show a study of the Jewish Lublin, Lvov, Vilna, and Rovne among others. Alter Kacyzne was a poet, dramatist, journalist, and editor as well as a photographer. He was originally commissioned by the "Forverts" to do these pictures of the more than 3 million Yiddish speaking Jews who called Poland their home. The book was published in 1999 in conjunction with YIVO. The book is on loan from the Denver Public Library.
