



## Research Trip Planned To Salt Lake Library

For the sixth consecutive year, veteran Jewish genealogists Gary Mokotoff and Eileen Polakoff will be offering a research trip to the LDS Family History Library in Salt Lake City from Nov. 4 to 11.

The comprehensive program offers genealogists the opportunity to spend an entire week of research at the library with the guidance and assistance of professional genealogists who have made more than two dozen trips to the Salt Lake City repository.

The trip includes a specially arranged three-hour class on the day of arrival, introducing participants to the FHL facilities and resources; a midweek informal group discussion of progress and problem-solving and access to trip leaders at the library from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. for on-site assistance and personal consultations.

A beginners workshop on the first morning of the trip introduces genealogy newcomers to the world of Hamburg (Germany) immigrations lists, U.S. passenger arrival lists, naturalization records and U.S. Census records. Part of the pre-trip literature includes a copy of the book "Making the Most of Your Trip to Salt Lake City."

Social events included are a midweek group brunch, special seating at the Sunday morning broadcast of the Mormon Tabernacle Choir, and an optional Sunday tour of Salt Lake City points of interest.
